## ORDINANCE #84-62

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #84-53.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Sandy City, Utah that:

Section 1: Section 8 of Ordinance #84-53 be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

- 8. No individual shall serve as a membér of more than one board, commission, committee or special committee of the City at the same time unless such dual service is specifically provided for by ordinance or by joint resolution creating the special eommittee. An individual may serve as a member of more than one board, commission, committee or special committee of the City at the same time unless such dual service is prohibited by law or ordinance.
- Section 2. All former ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance or of the Code hereby adopted are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable; and if any provision thereof, or the application of such provision under any circumstances is held invalid, it shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance, or the application in a different circumstance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective unpon its passage and recording as required by law.
