# BREWPUBS IN SANDY CITY

## **City Council Objectives**

- Consider and evaluate areas where "brewpubs" could be permitted, beyond the Cairns District
- Streamline the permitting process
- Lower the regulatory and financial barriers to entry
- Ensure Sandy Code is aligned with Utah Code
- Brewpub is a restaurant with brewery that sells beer and heavy beer for on-site consumption



## Findings

- Utah Department of Alcoholic Beverage Services will require two licenses
  - 1. Manufacturing brewery license
  - 2. Restaurant license to serve alcohol (A minimum of 70% food sales is required)
- State law will restrict brewpubs from locating within proximity to a "community location"
  - Public or private schools
  - Churches
  - Public libraries
  - Public playgrounds
  - Public parks

### Recommendations

- Neighborhood Activity Centers and the Ski Hub are good locations for a brewpub
- Allow brewpubs in zones that allow a restaurant that serves alcohol
  - Commercial, mixed use, office, industrial and special development commercial districts
- If a restaurant that serves alcohol is a permitted use in a zone, then a brewpub would be a permitted use in that zone (same approach for conditional uses)

### Recommendations

- Reduce alcohol license fee for a brewpub by charging only one \$219 fee for the site (vs. \$219 per license)
- Reduce costs and improve efficiency by eliminating all cash bonds requirements
