## A RESOLUTION OF THE SANDY CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE SALT LAKE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Sandy City Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Sandy City; and

WHEREAS, Salt Lake County, in coordination with Sandy City and other participating jurisdictions, has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Salt Lake County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan dated June 27, 2025 in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended: and

WHEREAS, the Salt Lake County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan dated June 27, 2025, identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Sandy City from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the Sandy City Council demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Salt Lake County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan dated June 27, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Sandy City, Utah, as follows:

1. The Salt Lake County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan dated June 27, 2025, is hereby adopted. Salt Lake County Emergency Management may make minor changes to the Mitigation Plan as needed to ensure that the Mitigation Plan remains current and reflects known hazards and best practices without Sandy City's approval. However, the approval of the Sandy City Council must be obtained for any significant changes or changes that increase costs.
