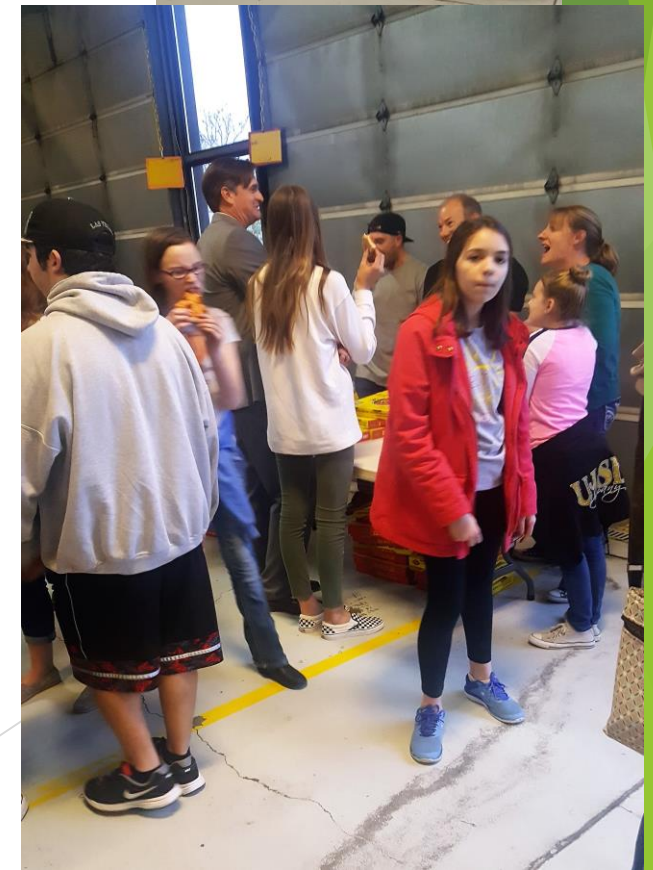

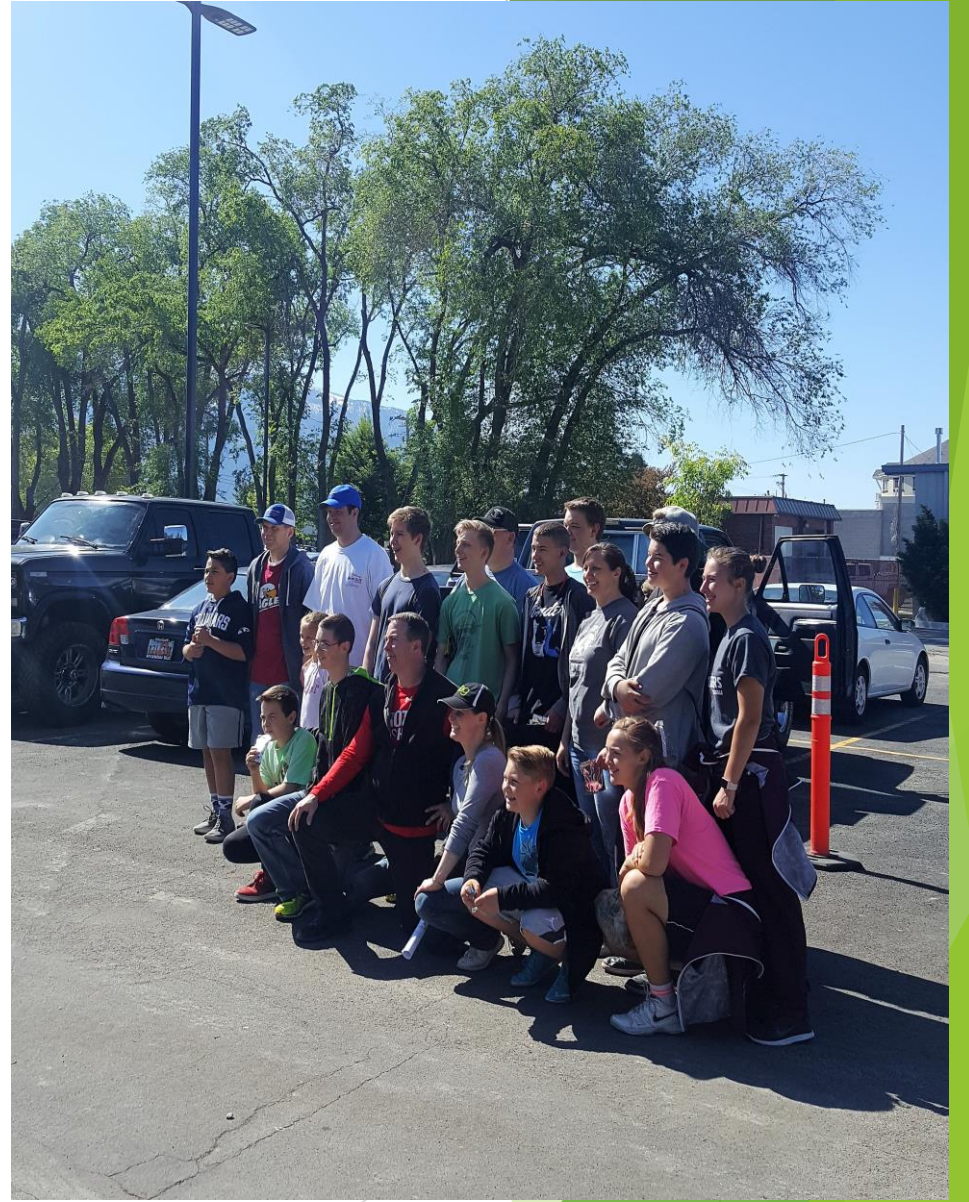

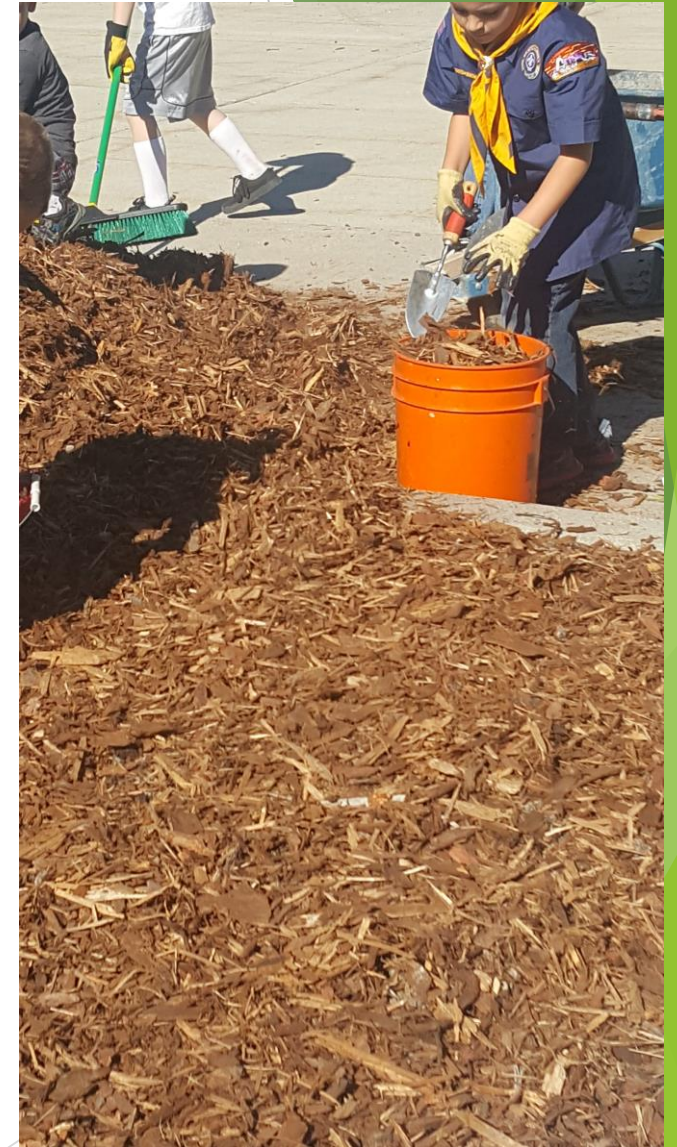

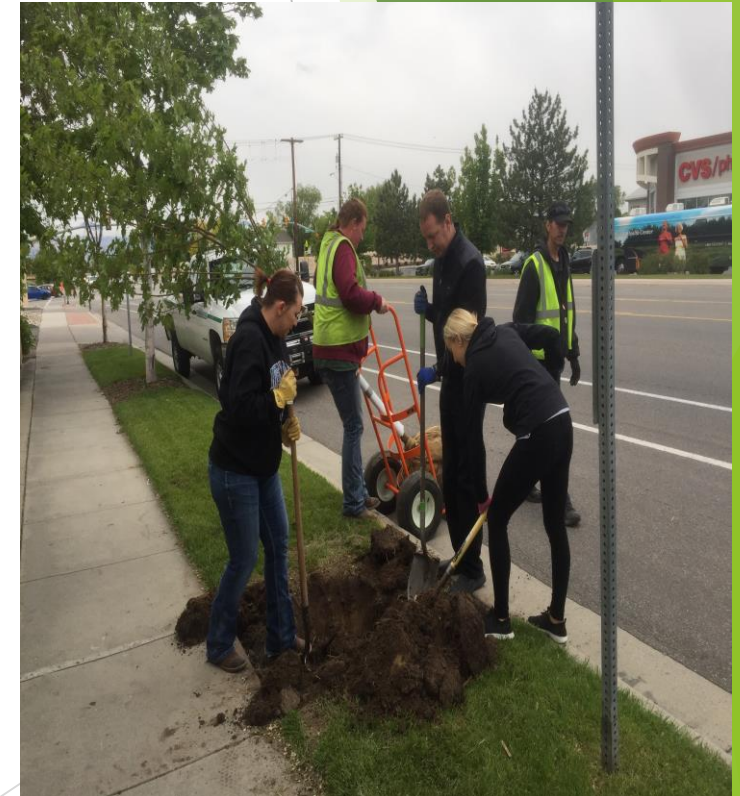

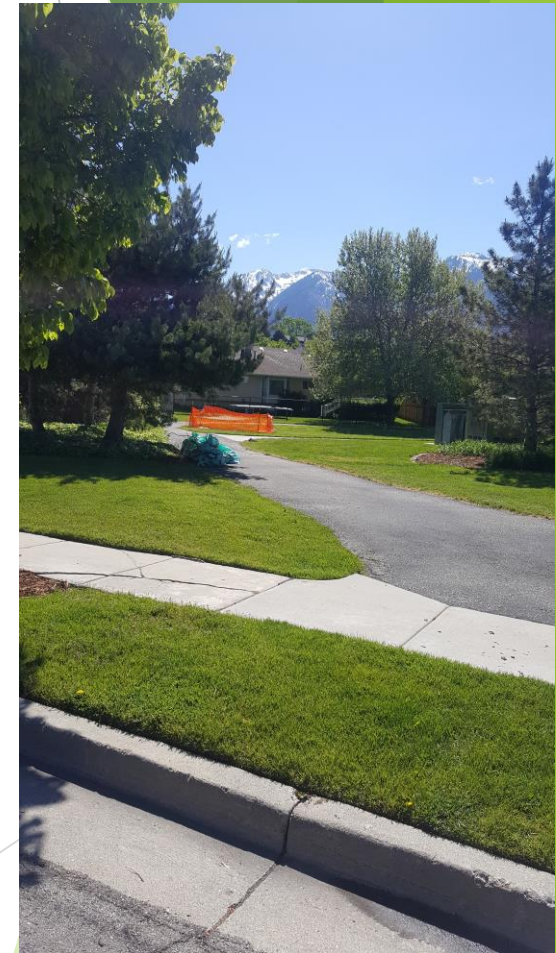

- ▶ - Planted 118 Trees.
- ▶ - Planted 117 Shrubs and grasses.
- ▶ - Planted 471 Flats of annual flower. (218 were planted at City Hall)
- ▶ - Planted 126 Perennials.
- ▶ - Delivered and spread 130 cubic yards of cedar bark and 75 cubic yards of playground wood chips.
- ▶ - 31 different projects through out the City for Sandy Pride.
- ▶ - Supplied 30 gal. of paint and painting materials.
- ▶ - 2,850 Total Service Hours.
- ▶ - \$40,000.00 in product. Total savings to the city is estimated at \$100,000.00 .
