A JOINT-RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND MAYOR OF SANDY CITY AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A SPECIAL COMMITTEE: THE ALTA CANYON ADVISORY COMMITEE

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that the Mayor and City Council of Sandy City, State of Utah, find and determine as follows:

WHEREAS Sandy City Council on October 19, 2021, adopted Resolution #21-34C, revoking all authority previously delegated to the Alta Canyon Recreation Special Service District Administrative Control Board effective January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Sandy City Code, Chapter 3, Section 3-1-7, the City Council and Mayor may jointly create special committees to advise the Council on legislative matters and the Mayor on administrative matters; and

WHEREAS Sandy City Council on September 11, 2018, adopted A Policy and Procedural Guide for the Appointment of Citizens, Staff, and Elected Officials to Serve on Special Committees ("Policy Manual"); and

WHEREAS the Policy and Procedural Guide defines "Special Committee" as a "standing group of Sandy City residents, Sandy City business owners, experts, or other individuals who are jointly appointed by the Mayor and City Council to advise them on matters of importance to the City"; and

WHEREAS Sandy City Council and Mayor recognize the need of an advisory committee as it relates to the future of the Alta Canyon Sports Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council and Mayor of Sandy that:

- 1. The "Alta Canyon Advisory Committee" shall be created to advise the City Council and Mayor on issues related to the Alta Canyon Sports Center in accordance with the Policy Manual.
- 2. This Resolution shall take effect on January 1, 2022.
