Subject: Adoption of Amendment to Sandy City Code, Title 1, Chapter 1-1, Section 1-1-6

## **BACKGROUND**

As previously adopted, the Sandy City Code allows City staff to make “nonsubstantive changes necessary to preserve the original meaning of the ordinances” inserted in the Code. Sandy City Code, Section 1-1-6(c). The proposed amendment would allow staff to “correct scrivener’s errors . . . to preserve the original meaning of the ordinances” in addition to “nonsubstantive changes.” A simple example of a scrivener’s error is Municode’s inadvertent omission of a term or terms expressly included in an ordinance approved by City Council.

## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that City Council approve Ordinance #19-33, amending Title 1, Chapter 1-1, Section 1-1-6 in the Sandy City Code.
