Hansen Apartments is a 259-apartment community for refugees fleeing occupied and dangerously impacted areas of Ukraine. These fully furnished apartments are home for over 500 individuals.

The Phoenix rebuilding program was initiated by the foundation with the support of local authorities of the Kyiv region. The HUM Foundation allocates up to \$ 30K for the reconstruction of the new house.

EXAMPLE OF THE PHOENIX PROJECT

The father is Igor Piskun, his wife Iryna, and two children. The family lived in the house they built with their own hands for 8 years. During the war, they stayed together in their basement for two weeks and then moved to their neighbors when the occupiers came for them.

HANSEN VILLAGE EXPANSION

PROJECTED COST - \$60 MM

Goals:

- 304 homes for families
- 92 homes for seniors
- Nursing care
- ~1,800 residents
- Community swimming pools
- Football field and indoor sports facility
- Retail center
- Solar panels and batteries

Projected cost for Phase 1 - \$8 MM



3 ACADEMY SCHOOLS



PROJECTED COST FOR EACH - \$12 MM

INNOVATIVE ENGLISH IMMERSION SCHOOL

1,200 students including 200 orphans, serving grades K through 11

- 41 classrooms
- library
- gymnasium
- auditorium and stage
- community counseling center
- outdoor athletic facilities
- art and music therapy

This building will remain open after hours for various community use. It will be solar assisted.

Our goal is to raise funds to build 10 new schools by September 2026.

PUKHIVKA VILLAGE

SOLAR POWERED, PLANNED COMMUNITY VILLAGE

PROJECTED COST - \$80 MM

Planned community in the Kyiv region for over **2,000 IDPs**. Housing units will include family, senior, and foster care units.

Amenities to include:

- English immersion school
- Retail and open-air market
- Community sports club
- Physical therapy center
- Football field
- Extended stay hotel




REHABILITATION CENTER

PROJECTED COST - \$22 MM

OUR CONTRIBUTION - \$6 MM for the shell infrastructure

Construction of an orthopedic-prosthetic clinic: at the base of the 2nd regional hospital in the city of Kyiv. This is a partnership between the government and international donors.
