

RESOLUTION #17-58C

A JOINT RESOLUTION CANCELING THE ELECTION OF
BOARD MEMBERS FOR ALTA CANYON SPECIAL SERVICE
DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Alta Canyon Special Service District ("District") has four at-large positions on its governing board to be elected this year, four candidates for those positions, and no write-in candidates; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. Section 17B-1-306(3)(a)(I) allows a special district to cancel an election the number of local district officer candidates for the at-large local district offices, including any eligible write-in candidates under Section 20A-9-601, does not exceed the number of open at-large local district offices for which the candidates have filed; and

WHEREAS, there are no other local district propositions on this year's ballot; and


WHEREAS, by canceling the election, the District will save approximately \$2,000 in election costs, as well as time and money; and

WHEREAS, the Council has no reason to believe that the four candidates for the at-large positions on the District board are not competent, qualified, and will not perform their services with judgment and diligence; and


WHEREAS, no purpose will be served by holding the election for the four positions,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Sandy City, that the City Council, jointly with the governing board of the District, hereby cancels the election for the four positions to be elected this year, and thereby the four candidates for the four positions on the governing board are hereby considered to be elected to that office as of November 7, 2017, the date previously scheduled for the election.
