

RESOLUTION #24-06C

A RESOLUTION OF THE SANDY CITY COUNCIL PERMITTING THE INTERDEPARTMENTAL TRANSFER OF PROPERTY FROM THE EVIDENCE ROOM TO THE POLICE IT

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Code, Title 77, Chapter 11d, Section 105, if the owner of any lost or mislaid property cannot be determined or notified, or if the owner of the property is determined and notified, and fails to appear and claim the property after three months of its receipt by the local law enforcement agency, and;

WHEREAS, the Sandy Police Department published notice of the intent to dispose of the unclaimed property on Utah’s Public Legal Notice Website established in Subsection 45-1-101(2)(b), and followed all other noticing requirements, and;

WHEREAS, no claim was made for the lost or mislaid property within nine days of publication and posting, and;

WHEREAS, the agency shall obtain permission to apply the property to a public interest use and the designation and approval of the public interest use of the property from the agency’s legislative body;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED, by the City Council of Sandy City that the Sandy City Police Department has complied with the requirements in Utah Code, Title 77, Chapter 11d, Section 105 and no claim has been made for the property shown in Exhibit “A”. Therefore, the attached request (Exhibit “A”) for interdepartmental transfer of property from the evidence room is approved and this resolution is effective upon adoption.

Reason for request:


