Dear Mr. McCuiston,

There are two sections of Creek Road where the Cottonwood Heights south border is at the center of the Creek Road and the Sandy City border is at the south right-of-way line of Creek road, leaving the eastbound lane and sidewalk in the unincorporated County (see red highlight on attached map.) Those sections of Creek Road are:

- Union Park Ave. (approximately 1200 East) to approximately 1760 East
- approximately 2010 East to approximately 2150 East

This peninsula creates inefficiencies and is confusing for the public. The Salt Lake County Public Works Department maintains and plows this stretch of road and approves road cuts. The Greater Salt Lake Municipal Services District (MSD) Planning Department approves access to this road for developments in Sandy City. The public calls Sandy City or Cottonwood Heights if there is a problem with the road because it is not clear that it is in the unincorporated County.

Public Works supports Sandy City annexing the south half of Creek Road in these two locations. This annexation would not include any private property.
