

ORDINANCE #19-33

AN ORDINANCE UPDATING THE SANDY CITY CODE BY AMENDING TITLE 1, "THE CODE; ORDINANCES; ETHICS", CHAPTER 1-1, "CODE ESTABLISHED; DEFINITIONS AND RULES OF CONSTRUCTION", SECTION 1-1-6, "SUPPLEMENTATION OF CODE"; ALSO PROVIDING A SAVING CLAUSE FOR THE ORDINANCE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Sandy City Code by amending Title 1, "The Code; Ordinances; Ethics", Chapter 1-1, "Code Established; Definitions and Rules of Construction", Section 1-1-6, "Supplementation of Code"; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-8-84, Utah Code Annotated, authorizes such amendment in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Sandy as follows:

Section 1. The Sandy City Code, Title 1, "The Code; Ordinances; Ethics", Chapter 1-1, "Code Established; Definitions and Rules of Construction", Section 1-1-6, "Supplementation of Code" is hereby amended as set forth in **Exhibit "A"** which is attached to and incorporated in this ordinance.

Section 2. All former ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance or of the Code hereby adopted are hereby repealed.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable; and if any provision thereof, of the application of such provision under any circumstances is held invalid, it shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance, or the application in a different circumstance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon publication of a summary thereof and the

City Recorder is hereby directed to publish such summary as soon as practically possible.

EXHIBIT "A"

Sec. 1-1-6. - Supplementation of Code.

- (a) Supplements to this Code shall be prepared and printed whenever authorized or directed by the city. A supplement to this Code shall include all substantive permanent and general parts of ordinances adopted during the period covered by the supplement and all changes made thereby in this Code. The pages of the supplement shall be so numbered that they will fit properly into this Code and will, where necessary, replace pages that have become obsolete or partially obsolete. The new pages shall be so prepared that, when they have been inserted, this Code will be current through the date of the adoption of the latest ordinance included in the supplement.
- (b) In preparing a supplement to this Code, all portions of this Code that have been repealed shall be excluded from this Code by the omission thereof from reprinted pages.
- (c) When preparing a supplement to this Code, the person authorized to prepare the supplement may make formal, nonsubstantive changes in ordinances and parts of ordinances included in the supplement, insofar as necessary to do so in order to embody them into a unified Code. For example, the person may:
 - (1) Arrange the material into appropriate organizational units.
 - (2) Supply appropriate catchlines, headings and titles for titles, chapters and sections to be included in this Code, and make changes in any such catchlines, headings and titles or in any such catchlines, headings and titles already in this Code.
 - (3) Assign appropriate numbers to titles, chapters and sections to be added to this Code.
 - (4) Where necessary to accommodate new material, change existing numbers assigned to titles, chapters or sections.
 - (5) Change the words "this ordinance" or similar words to "this title," "this chapter," "this section" or "sections _____ through _____" (inserting section numbers to indicate the sections of this Code that embody the substantive sections of the ordinance incorporated in this Code).
 - (6) Correct scrivener's errors and Mm make other nonsubstantive changes necessary to preserve the original meaning of the ordinances inserted in his Code.
