RESOLUTION NO. 21-07C**

**A RESOLUTION OF SANDY CITY AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE UTAH
STATE UNIVERSITY UTAH WELLBEING SURVEY PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, the Sandy City Council (the “Council”) met in a regularly scheduled meeting on January 26, 2021, to consider, among other things, authorizing participation in the Utah State University Utah Wellbeing Survey Project; and

WHEREAS, the Utah Wellbeing Survey Project (the “Project”) tracks local perspectives on wellbeing and change in Utah cities and towns in order to provide information to support local planning processes by tracking demographic characteristics; and

WHEREAS, the Project is conducted via an online survey in partnership with city leaders; the City is responsible for advertising and promoting participation in the Project survey; and

WHEREAS, participating cities can use data derived from the Project for a variety of purposes including, but not limited to, capital improvement prioritization and general planning processes; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the value of receiving community feedback when forming public policy, and desires to form public policy based on data-driven decisions supported by such community feedback; and

WHEREAS, participating in the Project may not only assist the City in forming City-wide public policy, but may also assist in creating more community-conscious state-wide policies as well; and

WHEREAS, participating in the Project bears little to no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the City’s citizens to participate in the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sandy City Council that City administrative personnel, employees, and other staff are hereby authorized to participate in the Utah State University Utah Wellbeing Survey Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is hereby directed to cooperate with Utah State University in participating in and completing the survey and other components of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council hereby authorizes the use of employee and staff time and other resources to complete participation in the Project.

This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 21-07c, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
