D. Equipment

25 Cameras for Patrol Officers

The JAG funds will be used to purchase 25 replacement cameras for patrol officers. These cameras are to be used to replace older or non-functioning ones. Officers continuously use their assigned cameras for logging crime scenes, accident scenes, etc. $(25 \times $294)$

Total for Cameras for Patrol Officers: \$7,350

1 Ninhydrin Chamber

The JAG funds will be used to purchase a new ninhydrin chamber to replace the department's current one with is over 10 years old has been having problems. The ninhydrin chamber is used for processing items with possible fingerprint impressions for criminal identifications. $(1 \times \$11,000)$

Total for Ninhydrin Chamber: \$11,000

Vehicle/Item Tracker for Narcotics Officers

The JAG funds will be used to purchase a vehicle/item tracker for use in narcotics investigations. The tracker will be used to track suspect and/or decoy items movements during criminals investigations. (1 x 893)
