**2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (CDBG)**

**NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 20, 2021 at or after 6:00 pm the Sandy City Council will hold a public hearing to consider approval of the 2021 Annual Action Plan (AAP) for the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

The April 20<sup>th</sup> Sandy City Council meeting will be conducted virtually, via Zoom Webinar. The April 20<sup>th</sup> agenda will be published at least 24 hours prior to the beginning of the meeting and can be found at <https://sandyutah.legistar.com/Calendar.aspx>.

Citizens wishing to comment on the proposed amendment must access the meeting via the Zoom Webinar link, which will be included on the April 20, 2021 meeting agenda (<https://sandyutah.legistar.com/Calendar.aspx>). If a citizen is unable to attend the meeting he or she may e-mail the City Council Executive Director at [mapplegarth@sandy.utah.gov](mailto:mapplegarth@sandy.utah.gov) by 3:00 PM on April 20, 2021 to have those comments distributed to the City Council and have them read into the record at the appropriate time. Alternatively, written comments may be posted directly to the public record using the eComment feature available on the April 20, 2021 City Council agenda.

CDBG funds are distributed to the City by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The City has been awarded \$387,379 in CDBG funds for the 2021 program year (7/1/2021-6/30/2022). Additionally, \$3,411 is being reprogrammed for a total of \$390,790 available for the program year. The draft of the 2021 AAP includes \$58,000 for public services, \$80,000 for housing, \$193,124 for public improvements, and \$59,666 for program administration and eligible planning.

Copies of the draft 2021 Annual Action Plan will be available for review and comment from March 27, 2021 through April 26, 2021 on the City's website (<https://sandy.utah.gov/736/Community-Development-Block-Grant-CDBG>), by hard copy at the Community Development Department at City Hall, and by request.
