

RESOLUTION #17-40 C

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SALT LAKE COUNTY AND SANDY CITY RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF DIMPLE DELL ROAD

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that the City Council of Sandy City, State of Utah, finds and determines as follows:

WHEREAS, Title 11, Chapter 13, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, permits public agencies to enter into cooperative agreements to provide joint undertakings and services; and

WHEREAS, Dimple Dell Road ("Road") runs through areas of City and unincorporated County, and was in need of emergency repair as a result of a pipe and road failure at DryCreek Crossing, approximately 10093 South Dimple Dell Road; and

WHEREAS, County and City each own and maintain a one-half interest in Road from approximately Dimple Dell Lane to Mount Jordan Road; and

WHEREAS, County and City desired to perform emergency repairs on this stretch of the Road; and

WHEREAS, City and County agreed for City to perform the emergency repairs, and that the County shall reimburse the City for County's share of the cost, as set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the best interests of the City and the general public will be served by the execution of the attached Interlocal Cooperation Agreement and by participating as required therein.

WHEREAS, the attached agreement has been prepared to accomplish such purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Sandy City, Utah:

1. It does hereby approve the attached agreement described as an interlocal agreement between the Salt Lake County and Sandy City relating to the emergency repair of Dimple Dell Road.

2. The Hon. Thomas M. Dolan, Mayor of Sandy City, is hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of Sandy City Corporation and to act in accordance with its terms.
