Michael Applegarth presented.

A motion was made by Scott Cowdell, seconded by Kristin Coleman-Nicholl, asking the Council to determine if they are desirous to continue with a discussion for a circuit breaker program for water assistance for individuals who qualify based on Salt Lake County's guidelines and are subject to budget constraints.

Council questions followed.

Council Member Smith called the question seconded by Steve Smith with a unanimous all in favor voice vote.

Chairman Cowdell was asked to repeat the motion. Mr. Cowdell was not speaking into the microphone for the motion to be heard. Chairman McCandless repeated the motion as follows:

Michael Applegarth asked the Council to clarify if they mean to add a "check box" on utility bills asking for a voluntary donation which would be separate from rate payer monies. The Council stated "Yes".

Mr. Applegarth stated that he would bring back a version that will include the

accounting for this type of program. The voluntary funds will need to be separate from rate paying funds, and criteria will need to be identified on how the money will be spent.
