Application for Code Amendment Title 21, Land Development Code

Proposal

- Amends definition of "Transitional Housing Facility" to draw a clear distinction between a "Transitional Housing Facility" and a "Homeless Shelter"
- Multiple zoning districts allow "Transitional Housing Facilities" with a Conditional Use Permit:
 - CBD, CR-PUD, RC, BC, CC, CN(HSN), and LC zones
 - Not Permitted in all other zones
- None existing Only affects new THFs



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Amended Definition

- Removes 30-day maximum stay
- Adds the following:
 - 24-month maximum stay
 - Non-congregate interim housing
 - Referral (non-walkup) basis only
 - On-site supportive services



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Sec. 21-37-21. "T" Definitions.

...

- (15) Transitional housing facility means a facility owned, operated, or contracted by a governmental entity or a charitable, nonprofit organization which provides free temporary non-congregate interim housing, on a referral (non-walkup) basis only, with on-site supportive services to homeless persons experiencing homelessness for no more than 30 days for a total anticipated stay of no more than 24 months while they obtain work, job skills, or otherwise take steps to stabilize their circumstances. A transitional housing facility does not include:
 - a. A homeless shelter;
 - b. A <u>detached single family</u> dwelling unit provided to a family for its exclusive use as part of a transitional housing program for more than 30 days; <u>andor</u>
 - c. A residential facility for persons with a disability.



Staff Recommendation to Planning Commission

Planning Commission forward a positive recommendation to the City Council to amend Title 21, of the Sandy Municipal Code, to amend the definition of a "Transitional Housing Facility," based on the findings in the staff report.
