Week 3

WHAT SANDY IS DOING

- Composts landscape waste and uses shade trees to reduce urban heat islands
- Uses LED/smart lighting on streets and motion sensor lighting in all facilities

- Mow less frequently and hand weed
- Sign up for energy-savings programs and install Energy Star® where possible

- Provides water-filling stations to reduce use of plastic water bottles

WHAT YOU CAN DO

- Sign up and use standard and glass curbside recycling
- Use refillable water bottles instead of plastic water bottles
