Eligible Voters must submit notice 65 days prior to election of intent to file an argument against bonds (No instruction on how to advertise) (59-1-1604)	September 1 st deadline
Governing body <u>shall</u> submit to the Election Officer an argument in favor of a ballot proposition (60 days prior to election)	September 8 th deadline
Last day any voter may submit to the Election Officer an argument against the ballot proposition (60 days prior to election)	September 8 th deadline
Election officer shall, <u>within one business day after the day on which the election officer receives both arguments</u> , send, via email or mail the pro to the con author and vice versa. (59-1-1604(3))	Next Business Day after receipt of both Pro and Con.
