Interlocal Agreement with Salt Lake County regarding TRCC Funding

The County receives funds pursuant to the Tourism, Recreation, Cultural, Convention, and Airport Facilities Tax Act ("TRCC Funds"), which can be used for certain capital projects and consulting work by public entities within the County. In 2024, Sandy City submitted a proposal for TRCC Funds from Salt Lake County for improvements to Bicentennial Park, which will be completed in 2025. The matching funds for this grant are in two capital line items, which were approved as part of the FY25 budget.

This proposal was approved for TRCC Funding by the County, and the County is now seeking the City's approval of its proposed Interlocal Cooperation Agreement. Because the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement pertains to improvements to real property (either directly or indirectly) and/or the County's sharing of its tax revenue, City Council approval of the Agreement is required under the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

The Resolution and/or the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (attached) give a summary explanation of what costs will be reimbursed under this Agreement, if approved.

We are presenting the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement to the Council for a first reading on April 15, 2025, and we hope to receive the Council's formal approval for this Agreement at the April 22, 2025, Council meeting.
