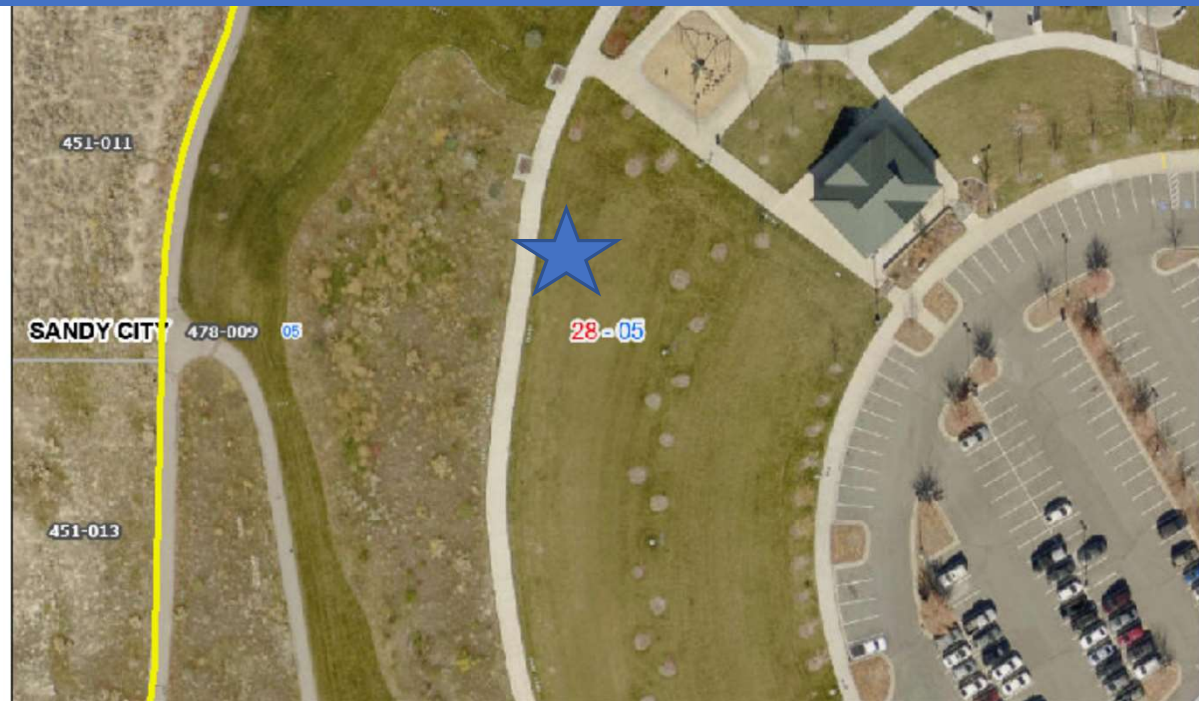

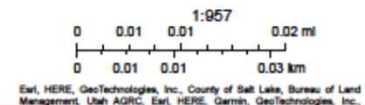


# Proposed Location and Description

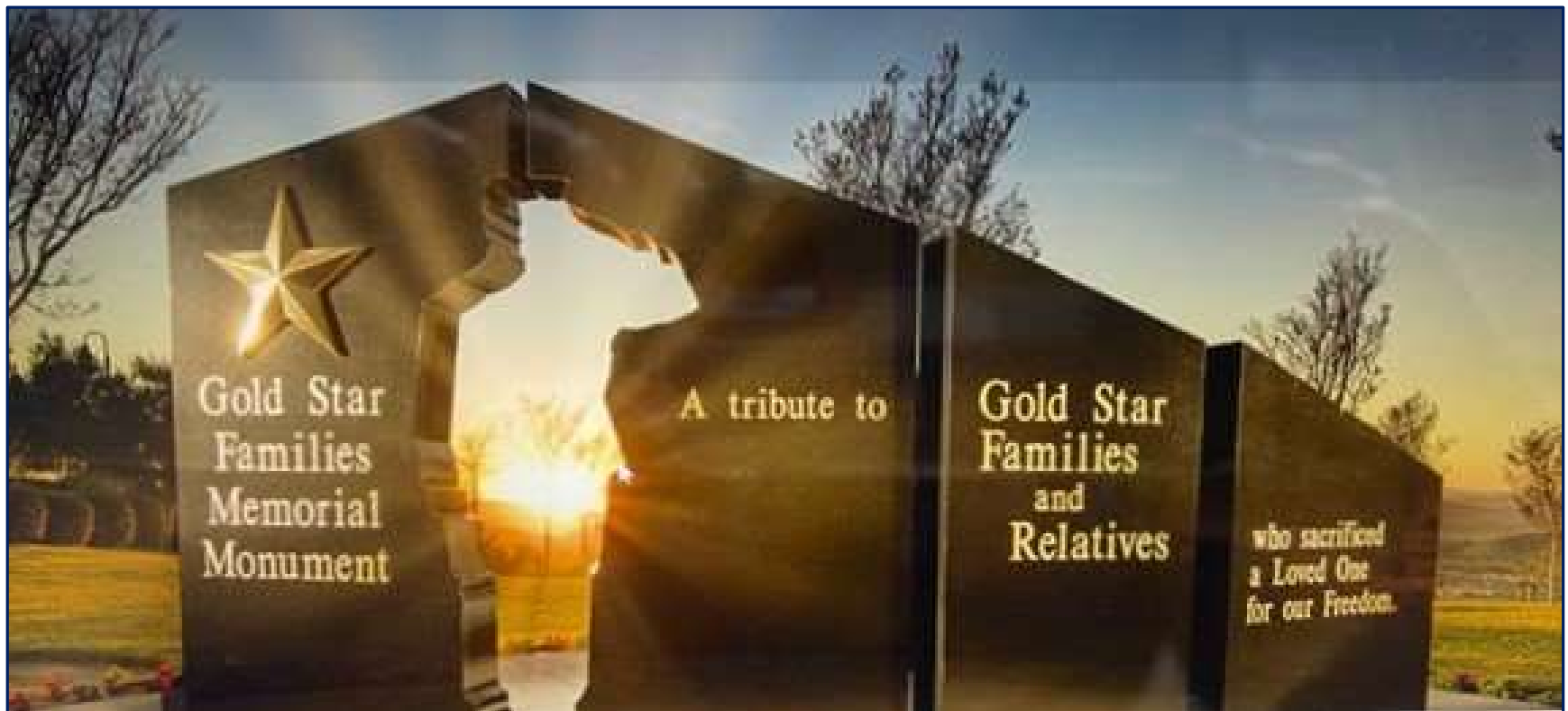
- Sandy Amphitheatre Park

# The Gold Star Monument

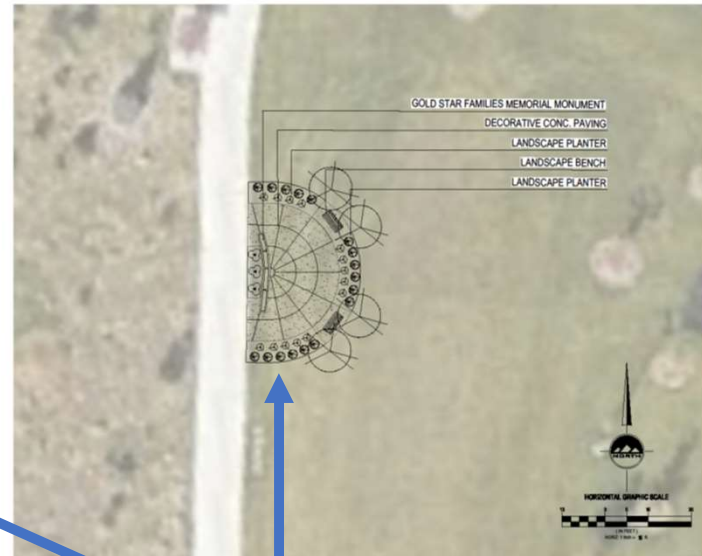
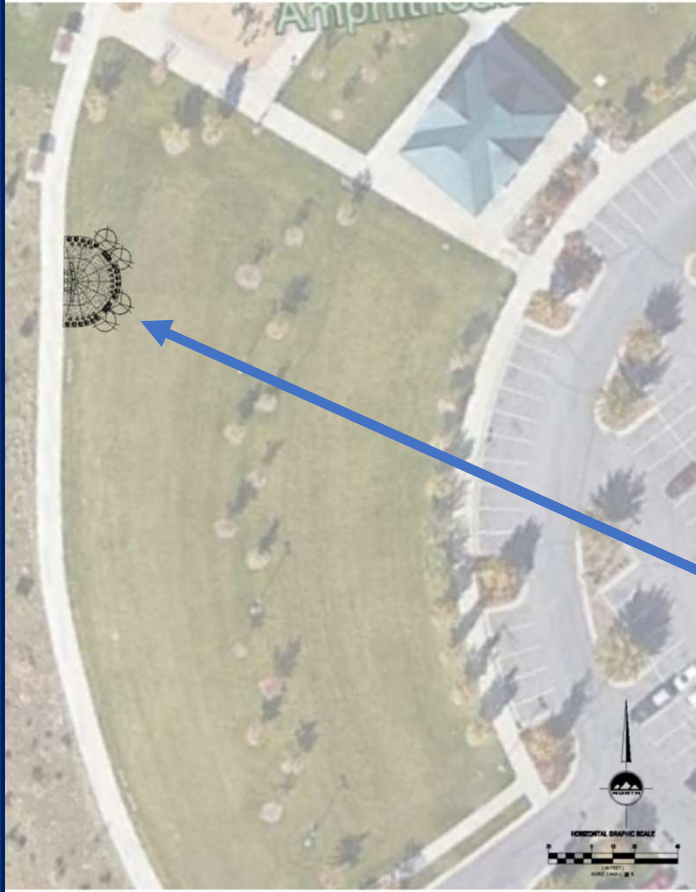

Notes:

1. Minimize site work to decrease existing landscape damage
2. Incorporate existing trees and lighting on site
3. Remove one or two existing coniferous trees to open unobstructed corridor

**For Sandy City to allow the committee to secure a perpetual easement on the site.**

- Sandy Mayor/Council approval – April 2022
- Fundraising completion – June 2022
- Ordering the granite – June 2022
- Site work planning and approval by City Staff – July – 2022
- Commencement of site work – July 2022
- Installation of Monument – August/September 2022
- Sandy City Gold Star Families Monument Dedication – September 2022
