## ORDINANCE 21-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF TITLE 1, "THE CODE; ORDINANCES; ETHICS" CHAPTER 1-1, "CODE ESTABLISHED; DEFINITIONS AND RULES OF CONSTRUCTION", TITLE 9, "STORMWATER" CHAPTER 9-1, "ILLICIT DISCHARGE AND EROSION CONTROL", TITLE 10, "STREET AND PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS" CHAPTER 10-1, "EXCAVATION PERMIT" AND CHAPTER 10-8, "STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS" OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF SANDY CITY BY ADOPTING REVISIONS THERETO, AND ALSO PROVIDING A SAVING CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Sandy City has determined that it is necessary to amend Chapters 1-1, 9-1, 10-1 and 10-8 of the Revised Ordinances of Sandy City relating to Storm Water and Flood Plains standards; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-8-84, Utah Code Annotated, authorizes such amendment in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Sandy City as follows:

- Section 1. Chapters 1-1, 9-1, 10-1 and 10-8 of the Revised Ordinances of Sandy City are hereby amended as set forth in **Exhibit "C"** which is attached to and incorporated in this ordinance.
- Section 2. All former ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance or of the Code hereby adopted are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable; and if any provision thereof, or the application of such provision under any circumstances is held invalid, it shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance, or the application in a different circumstance.
- Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon the later of publication of a summary thereof or sixty days and the City Recorder is hereby directed to publish such summary as soon as practically possible.
