

## Timeline for Dissolution of Alta Canyon Recreation District

1. Council gives notice required of Council action to dissolve the District. (allowing not less than the min. time for any other Council action)
2. Council holds a hearing and decides whether to dissolve the Alta Canyon Rec. District by vote with a finding that the District is no longer needed for the purpose for which it was created (or that the District shall discontinue service(s) which the District provides), and
  - a. No bond, note or other obligation of the District is outstanding and unpaid (or adequate provision has been made for payment of such bond, note or other obligation, or the other parties agree), and
  - b. No contractual obligation to provide services exists.
3. Within 30 days after the resolution, the Council shall file with the Lieutenant Governor a copy of the resolution of dissolution.
4. District deeds its property to Sandy City - not required by statute but needed to complete the process. The deed could be prepared but delivery withheld until the certificate of dissolution is received from the Lt. Gov. or perhaps a conditional conveyance could be made.
5. Upon the Lieutenant Governor's issuance of a certificate of dissolution (which effectively dissolves the district), the certificate shall be filed with the Salt Lake County Recorder, along with a certified copy of the resolution approving the dissolution.
