## **ORDINANCE 20-01**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12, "ANIMAL SERVICES" CHAPTER 1, "ANIMAL CONTROL" SECTION 2, SECTION 7, AND SECTION 21, OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF SANDY CITY BY ADOPTING REVISIONS THERETO, AND ALSO PROVIDING A SAVING CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City Council of Sandy City has determined that it is necessary to amend Sections 12-1-2, 12-1-7 and 12-1-21 of the Revised Ordinances of Sandy City relating to the "Animal Control", Title 12, "Animal Services" of the Revised Ordinances of Sandy City; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-8-84, Utah Code Annotated, authorizes such an amendment in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Sandy City as follows:

Section 1. Title 12, Chapter 1, Section 2, "Definitions", Section 7, "Licensing" and Section 21, "Impounding-Animals to be Impounded" of the Revised Ordinances of Sandy City are hereby amended as set forth in **Exhibit A** which is attached to and incorporated in this ordinance.

Section 4. All former ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable. If any provision thereof, or the application of such provision under any circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance, or the application in a different circumstance.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective upon publication of a summary thereof and the City Recorder is hereby directed to publish such summary as soon as practically possible.
