



SANDY CITY PUBLIC WORKS CAPITAL PROJECTS



Engineering (City Engineer: Ryan Kump, P.E.)

- Project Design, Contracting and Construction Management – In-house and contracted.
- Inspections – Ensure conformance with standard.
- Surveying – City projects, legal descriptions, title information, deeds, etc.
- Road Cut Permits – Coordinate permits, bonding and insurance for all work in public way.
- Geographic Information System (GIS) – Provide database, mapping, specialty programs and web services. Track and record data for GASB 34.
- Development Review – Engineering review and coordination with developers and other City departments.
- Grants – Apply for & manage construction grants.

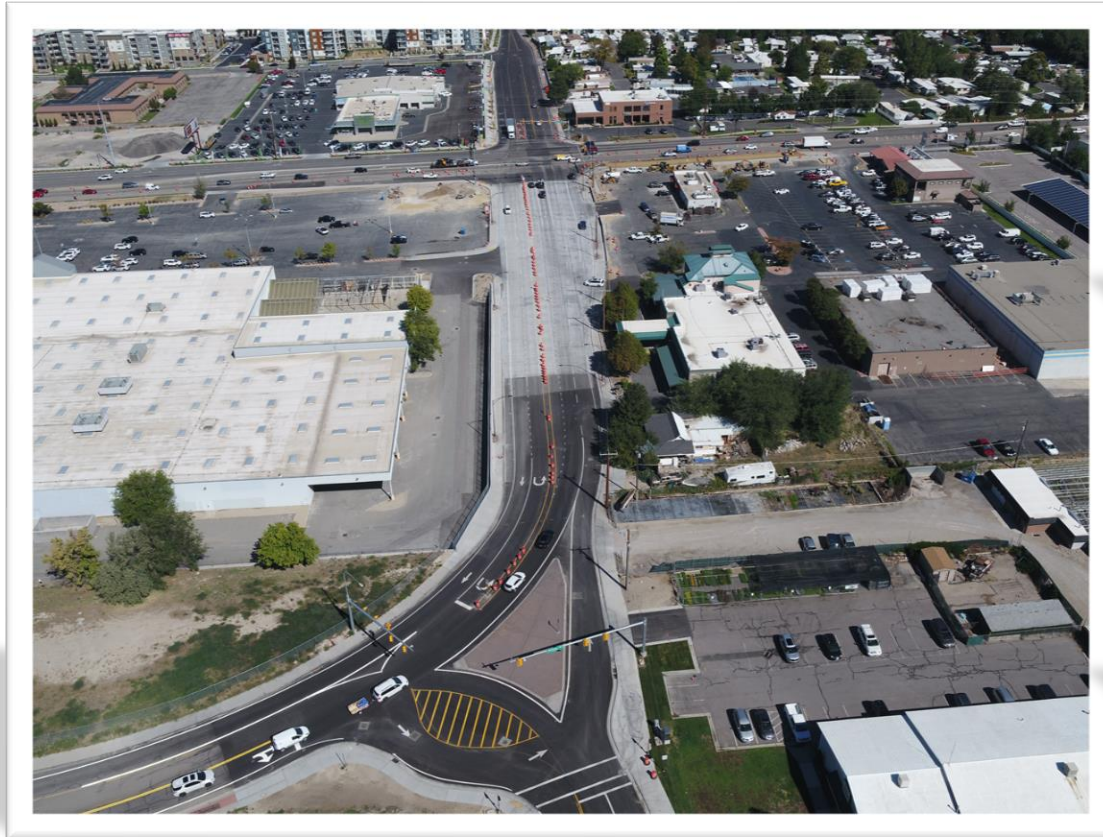

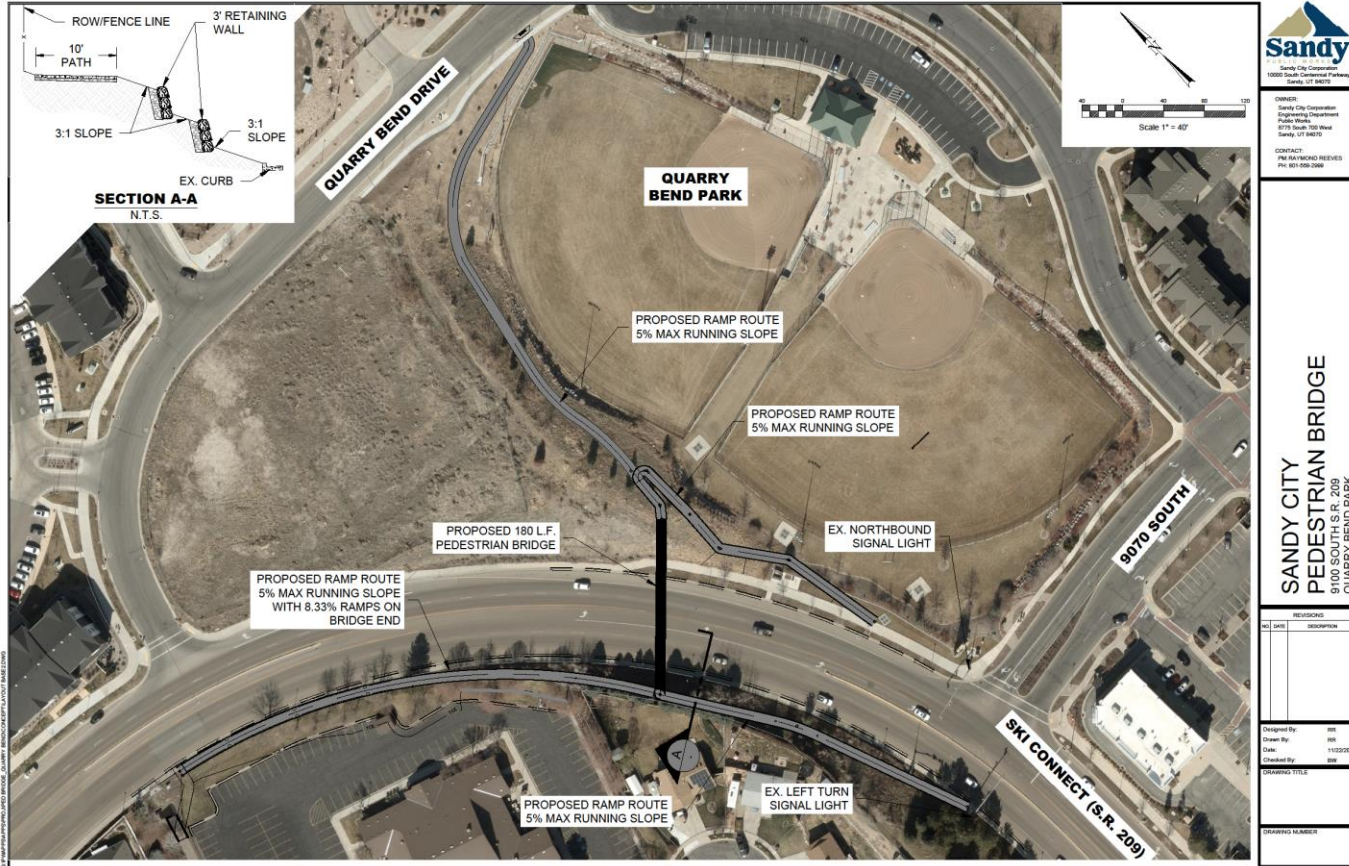
