

## **EXHIBIT “A”**

### Title 2 – ELECTIONS

#### CHAPTER 2-1. ELECTION RULES AND REGULATIONS

##### Sec. 2-1-6. - Campaign Contribution Limits

###### (1) Definitions

For the purpose of this chapter the following words shall have the meaning given herein.

*“Candidate”* is any person who:

- (a) Files a declaration of candidacy for an elected office of the City;
- (b) Receives contributions, makes expenditures, or consents to another person receiving contributions or making expenditures on his or her behalf with a view to bringing about such person’s nomination or election to such office; or
- (c) Causes, on his or her behalf, any written material or advertisement to be printed, published, broadcast, distributed or disseminated which indicates or promotes his or her intention to seek such office.

*“Contribution”* means:

- (a) A gift, subscription, donation, loan, advance, or deposit of money or anything of value, including nonmonetary contributions such as in-kind contributions and contributions of tangible things, made for the election of a candidate or to oppose a candidate, or to promote or oppose an issue on a referendum, except a loan of money by a financial institution made in accordance with the applicable financial institution’s laws and regulations and in the ordinary course of business;
- (b) A contract, promise or agreement, express or implied, whether or not legally enforceable, to make a contribution described in subsection (a) of this definition;
- (c) A transfer of funds between a political committee and a candidate’s personal campaign committee;
- (d) Compensation paid by a person other than the candidate’s personal campaign committee for personal services of another person rendered without charge to the candidate or such candidate’s personal campaign committee; or
- (e) A coordinate expenditure.
- (f) Provided, however, that *“Contribution”* shall not include personal services provided without compensation by individuals volunteering their time on behalf of a candidate, or by such candidate’s personal campaign committee.

*“Election”* - means a general, primary or special election for the office of Mayor or City Council within Sandy City, or an election for referendum or bonds issues.

*“Election Cycle”* means:

- (a) with respect to a general City election or a City primary election for an elective position, the four (4)-year period that begins on January 1 immediately following the last general City election for such elective position, and ends on December 31 immediately following the election for such position; and
- (b) with respect to an election to fill an unexpired term of office, the period that begins on the earlier of (i) the day the vacancy occurs, or (ii) the day the impending vacancy is publicly announced, and ends on December 31 immediately following the next general City election for such elective position.

*“Person”* - means both natural and legal persons including, but not limited to, individuals, business organizations, personal campaign committees, political committees, party committees, labor unions, labor organizations and any other organized group of individuals.

*“Personal Campaign Committee”* – means the committee appointed by or organized in support of a particular candidate to act for a candidate running for Mayor or City Council.

*“Political Committee”*- means a group of people cooperating to aid or promote the success or defeat of a candidate or issue, including making contributions to a personal campaign committee, a political action committee, a ballot initiative committee or an independent political expenditure committee.

(2) Contributions to Candidates; Limitations

No person shall make any contribution during any election cycle, as set forth in this chapter, to any candidate or his or her personal campaign committee, or to any political committee with respect to any election for Mayor or City Council within the City, that, in the aggregate, exceeds \$2,500.00.

(3) Anonymous Contributions Prohibited

The acceptance of anonymous contributions is prohibited. Any anonymous contributions received by a candidate or a personal campaign committee or a political committee shall be transmitted to the City Treasurer for deposit in the general fund of the City. Each contributor of a contribution shall disclose to the personal campaign committee or political committee the name and address of such contributor.

(4) Contributions in the Name of Another Prohibited

No person shall make a contribution in the name of another person or make a contribution with another person’s funds in his or her own name, and no personal campaign committee or political committee shall knowingly accept any such contribution.

(5) Use of Candidate’s Own Resources Not Limited

The limitations imposed above of this section shall not apply to contributions by a candidate of the candidate’s own resources to the candidate’s own campaign.
