

Sec. 20-6-4. - Discharge of Fireworks.

Due to the presence of existing hazardous environmental conditions, the discharge of fireworks, as defined in U.C.A. 1953, § 53-7-202(14), is hereby prohibited within, into, or over the following areas:

- (1) Mountainous, brush-covered, forest-covered, or dry grass-covered areas;
- (2) Within 200 feet of waterways, trails, canyons, washes, ravines, vacant lots, or similar areas where natural or unmaintained vegetation is present;
- (3) The wildland urban interface area, which means the line, area, or zone where structures or other human development meet or intermingle with undeveloped wildland or land being used for an agricultural purpose; and
- (4) Those areas of the City specifically described as prohibited in Exhibit "B" of the ordinance from which this section is derived, copies of which ordinance and exhibit have been filed for use and examination by public in the office of the Sandy City Recorder.
