After the meeting had been duly called to order and after other matters not pertinent to this resolution had been discussed, the City Recorder presented to the Council a Certificate of Compliance With Open Meeting Law with respect to this December 6, 2023 meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

The Council thereupon made a proper canvass of the election returns of said special election in accordance with Sections 11-14-207, 20A-4-301(3), 20A-4-302 and 20A-4-303, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, including making publicly available at the meeting the return of voting for each precinct, and at conclusion of the canvass made the following official findings:

PROPOSITION

Shall the City Council (the "Council") of Sandy City, Utah (the "City"), be authorized to issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed Twenty-One Million (\$21,000,000) (the "Bonds") for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the costs of constructing and equipping a fire station and all related improvements; said Bonds to be due and payable in not to exceed twenty (20) years from the date of issuance of the Bonds?

<u>Property Tax Cost of Bonds</u>: If the Bonds are issued as planned a property tax sufficient to pay debt service on the Bonds will be required over a period of twenty (20) years in the estimated average amount of \$39.44 per year on a \$628,000 primary residence and in the estimated amount of \$71.70 per year on a business property having the same value.

The foregoing information is only an estimate and is not a limit on the amount of taxes that the Council may be required to levy to pay debt service on the Bonds. The Council is obligated to levy taxes to the extent provided by law in order to pay the Bonds. The amounts are based on various assumptions and estimates, including estimated debt service on the Bonds and taxable values of property in Sandy City, Utah.
