Re: Reappointment of Public Utilities Advisory Board Members

On December 31, 2021, the terms for four members of the Public Utilities Board will end, three of which are appointed by Council and one of which is a Mayoral appointee. Those currently up for Council reappointment are: Jeff Budge, John Kirkham and Don Milne. The Public Utilities department respectfully recommends these three board members to be reappointed. The current board has brought expertise and works well together. These three individuals are valuable to the board and the Public Utilities department.

We have spoken to each of these board members and each has expressed interest in continuing to serve Sandy. We respectfully recommend reappointment of Jeff Budge, John Kirkham and Don Milne to the Public Utilities Advisory Board.

All of these terms end December 31, 2021 and would be extended to December 31, 2023. The PUAB has two year terms.
