### 1. Opening Remarks/Prayer/Pledge of Allegiance

#### **Public Hearing**

3. Council Member Nicholl recommending the City Council approve Ordinance 16-15 to amend the Sandy City Land Development Code Title 15A, Chapters 03, Officers, Boards and Commissions; 33, Conditional Use Permit; and 35, Appeals and Variances; and other relevant land use sections, if any, that may affect Conditional Use Permit appeals. The purpose of the Code Amendment is to consider changing the appeal authority for Conditional Use Permits and would identify the Board of Adjustment as the appeal authority for Conditional Use Permits instead of the City Council.

Brian McCuistion presented the staff report for this item to the Council. He noted that it went to the Planning Commission on March 17, 2016 and they forwarded a positive recommendation to the City Council.

Chairwoman Nicholl opened the public hearing for this item. There being no public comment, Chairwoman Nicholl closed the public hearing for this item.

Council Member Smith made a motion to have paperwork brought back to adopt Ordinance 16-15 amending Title 15A of the revised ordinances of Sandy City, the Land Development Code of 2008 by amending Chapters 3, Officers, Boards and Commissions; 33, Conditional Use Permit; and 35, Appeals and Variances; and other relevant land use sections, if any, that may affect Conditional Use Permit appeals to change the appeal authority for Conditional Use Permits and identify the Board of Adjustment as the appeal authority for Conditional Use Permits and also providing a saving clause and an effective date.

Mr. Applegarth noted that the Ordinance for this item is in the packet so the Council could adopt tonight.

Council Member Smith amended his motion to adopt Ordinance 16-15. Council Member Fairbanks seconded the motion.
