- ▶ 70,900 pounds of used oil
- ▶ 36,108 pounds of antifreeze
- ▶ 132,880 pounds of fuel
- ➤ 59,012 pounds of fertilizer, herbicides, and pesticides
- ▶ 44,507 pounds of aerosols
- ▶ 56,205 pounds of t-Ox chemicals
- ▶ 118,339 pounds of electronics
- ▶ 3,633 pounds of florescent light bulbs



    - ▶ 2 -4 week soft opening





