

SANDY CITY FALL 2017 BULK WASTE PROGRAM

Spring 2017 challenges:

- Wind Storm
- Illegal dumping
 - Non-residents (opportunistic dumping from adjacent city residents)
 - Contractors (drive-by dumping)
 - Poor advice from retailer (“just dump it in Sandy”)
- Large scale individual abuses
 - dumping “Will Not Pick Up” items
 - Landscape and Renovation contractors

Cost:

- 2 plus week delay to complete
- \$552,945 (average spring bulk waste cost is \$420,000)
- 3,818 truck-loads (average spring is 2,476 truck-loads)

What can we control? (Not a windstorm!)

Bulk Waste

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The 2021 Bulk Waste collection begins on September 11. Watch for your date in the mail and please follow the guidelines listed below:

Program Guidelines

1 Place bulk waste outside no sooner than the **Saturday** prior to your scheduled collection date (no later than 7:00 a.m.).

2 Do not put waste on the sidewalk, against a fence, on top of a utility box or storm water inlet grate.

3 Place all green waste (limbs, branches, wood) in one pile. Place all other trash into a separate pile (two feet away).

4 Don't park within 15 feet of either pile to allow the loader to have enough space to work.

5 Loose material: leaves, twigs, pine needles, wood chips, etc.) should be placed inside trash bags or boxes.

6 Lawnmowers and other similar items must have the oil and gasoline removed.

7 55-gallon containers should be emptied and have either the top removed or be cut in half.

8 All materials including tree limbs and stumps should be cut into 4 foot lengths and be no more than 10" in diameter.

9 If you hire a landscaper or carpenter to do work at your home, they are responsible for removing contractor debris.

10 Hauling to another location is considered illegal dumping. If you see illegal dumping, please get the license plate number and contact the Police Department at 801.700.3000.

Items Sandy City WILL NOT pick up

- Rocks, concrete, gravel, dirt or soil.
- Construction debris such as steel roof, tile, glass, roofing materials or lumber.
- Vehicle parts, tires or propane tanks.
- Oil, gas, battery, paint, flammable, toxic or hazardous chemicals. For disposal of household hazardous waste call Salt Lake County Health Department at (801) 466-5850.
- Items containing a refrigerant such as A/C units, refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners must have the chemical removed by a professional and a copy of the receipt must be attached to it.

A few restrictions

- No items that will be reused, please consider donating them at a local store.
- Stump grinding is discouraged.
- Items are waste placed outside earlier than allowed (a copy sent to the city, up date, please contact code enforcement at 801-466-5850).
- Again, this website is informational only. For more information, please contact the Police Department or Sandy City.

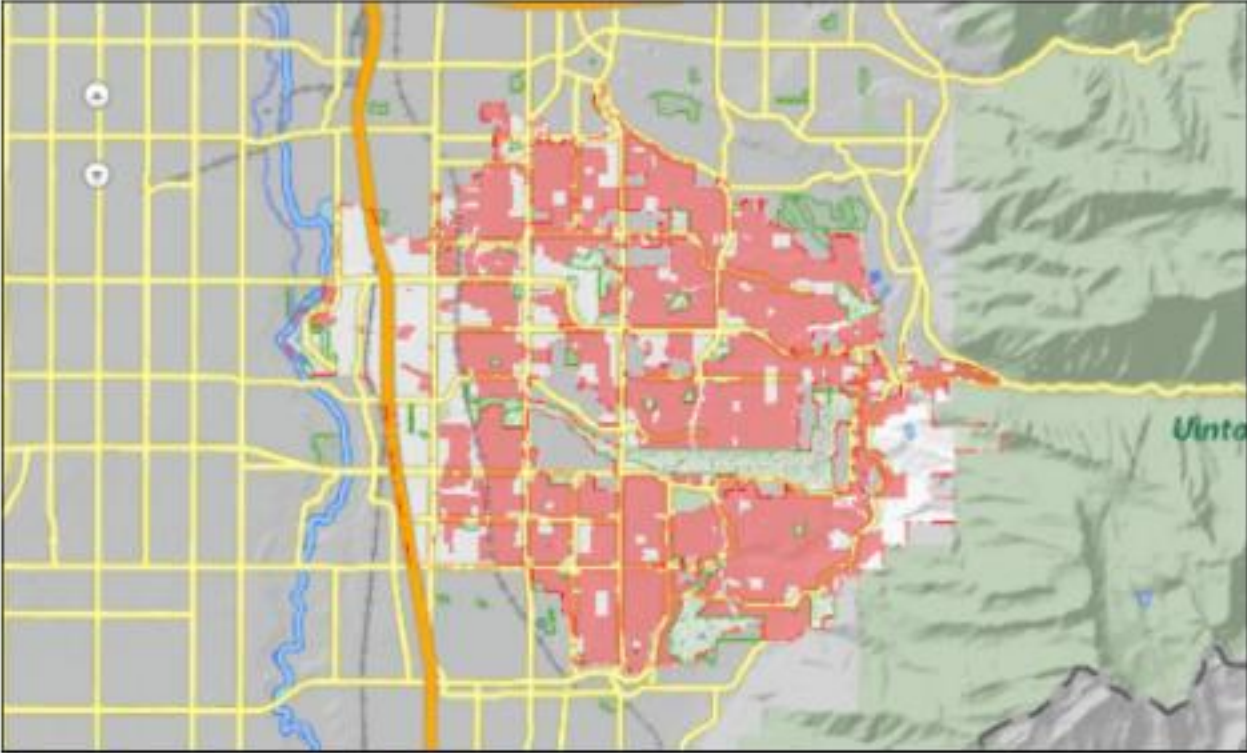
