REQUEST

On behalf of the City, the Community Development Department is requesting to amend Title 15A, Land Development Code by publishing and codifying the Sandy City Land Development Ordinances online.

BACKGROUND

City Staff has been working on this project over the past couple of years. The City has contracted with Municode, an online publisher and codifier of municipal codes, to publish and codify the Sandy City Municipal Code. Staff is very excited about this and feel that there are many benefits to us and the citizens who wish to access the City's regulations.

ANALYSIS

In preparing the codification, City Staff and Attorneys have made minor revisions targeting stylistic concerns, non-substantive clarifications, and eliminating redundancies. City Staff decided that any substantive changes would need to go through the typical code amendment process.

One change of note is that hereafter the Land Development Code will now be Title 21 versus the current Title 15A. This was a decision to place the Land Development Code at the end of the Municipal Code rather than in the middle.
