I am unfortunately unable to attend this meeting but I would like to give you some of my personal input, I moved into this neighborhood in 1997, and at that time my son was 9 years old, and at that time we were told that there would be changes coming to the center. ... he is now 32, and there has never been a time when I could just drop off my child at the rec center for him to go play a game of basketball, to walk around a track, to go for a swim (when it wasn't the middle of the summer), there is virtually nothing for children to do at Alta Canyon, there is not even an outdoor basketball standard, not one, the pool could at least have a bubble over it so that it could be used in the winter, there could be a basketball court and a full gymnasium, right now you have racquetball courts converted into exercise rooms that are really claustrophobic, it's so outdated it needs to expand.

Look at what Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center has done with their rec center compared to Alta Canyon Rec Ctr. They have five or six pools, both indoor and out, ice-skating rink, basketball court, running track indoors, skate park, tennis courts and everything and they pay about the same amount of money that a local resident at Alta canyon will pay but it out the canyon you have a swimming pool that operates for 12 weeks out of the year and the rest of the year that building is virtually empty. What a waste of space. They absolutely need to put money into the facility and bring it up to speed and have something for the people in this neighborhood, we have been paying for this facility for more than 20 years and we have gotten virtually nothing out of it. I would highly support any efforts to try to make the center bigger and better.
