 - Education/outreach
- Efficient use of Recorder staff time
- Accessible to the public
 - Searchability
 - Consistent format
 - Data validation
- Flexibility to include additional data fields
- Costs
- Fully tested prior to implementation

- Rules & Auditing Tools
- Detailed Search & Reporting
- Easy Data Export
 - Potential to integrate with Microsoft Business intelligence to create public information dashboards
- Automated Workflows
 - Uploads for public viewing
 - Sharing information with Lt. Gov's Office
- Costs
 - \$2,500 annually
 - \$5,000 in one-time costs for configuration & training
