Sandy City is committed to being a sustainable community and reducing our energy and carbon footprint. Energy efficiencies, recycling efforts, and alternative modes of transportation are key to creating a more sustainable community. Accordingly, the Sustainable Sandy 360° Initiative was launched in 2019 and highlights the efforts of Sandy City and its partners. In an effort to promote environmental awareness and to improve our sustainability efforts, we partnered with Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) and the Wattsmart Communities Program to identify energy efficiencies. Sandy City has shown commitment to promoting sustainability in the community through our Sustainable Sandy 360° Initiative and the Wattsmart Community Program built upon these efforts through collaboration with our community.
