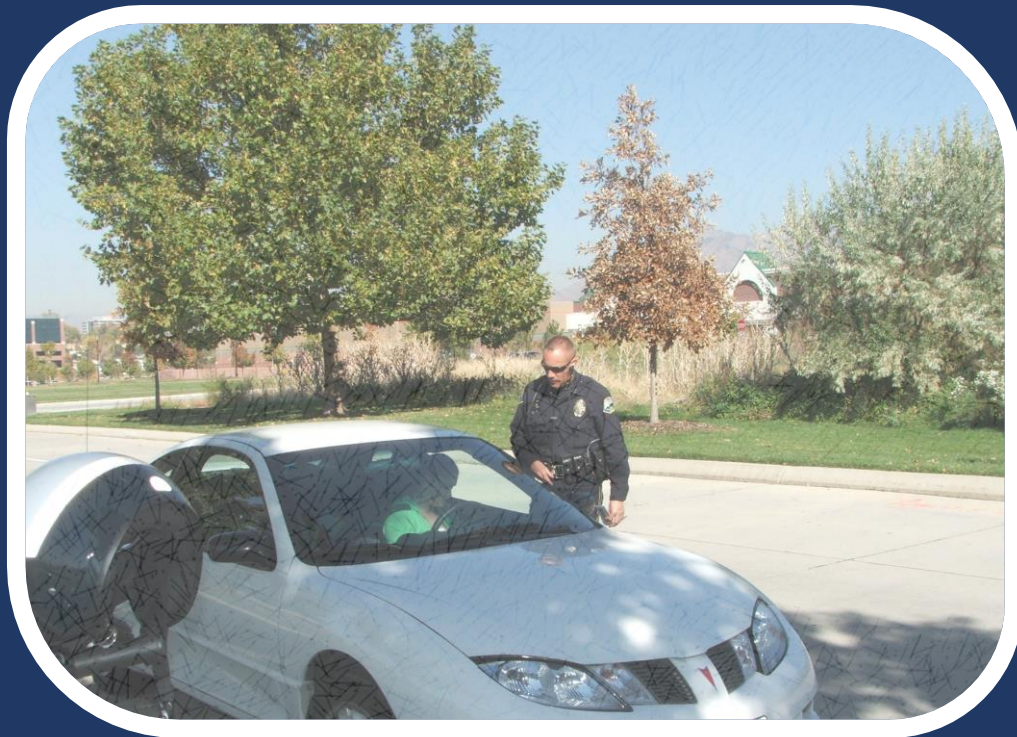

- Daily 2 – 4 hour shifts strictly focused on traffic enforcement.
- Shifts occur between 6:00 A.M. and 9:00P.M.
- Focused on residential streets and secondary arterial roadways.
- Emphasis on school zones, red light violations, speeding and DUI's.
- Locations are driven by complaints.
