Interlocal Agreement with Salt Lake County regarding TRCC Funding for Sandy Recreation Center

The County receives funds pursuant to the Tourism, Recreation, Cultural, Convention, and Airport Facilities Tax Act (“TRCC Funds”), which can be used for certain capital projects and consulting work by public entities within the County. In 2025, Sandy City submitted a proposal for TRCC Funds from Salt Lake County for funds for the construction of the Sandy Recreation Center, which will be completed in 2027.

This proposal was approved for TRCC Funding by the County, and the County is now seeking the City’s approval of its proposed Interlocal Cooperation Agreement. Because the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement pertains to improvements to real property (either directly or indirectly) and/or the County’s sharing of its tax revenue, City Council approval of the Agreement is required under the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

The Resolution and/or the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (attached) give a summary explanation of what costs will be reimbursed under this Agreement, if approved, and the City’s obligations under the Agreement.

We hope to receive the Council’s formal approval for this Agreement at the April 14, 2026, Council meeting.
