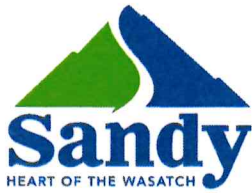

She possesses exceptional qualifications, extensive governmental finance experience, and a proven record of leadership in municipal financial management that will serve the City and its residents well.

Mindy Finlinson is a Certified Public Accountant licensed in the State of Utah with more than fifteen years of progressively responsible experience in governmental finance, treasury management, public accounting, and executive financial leadership.
