### **Proposed Redistricting Timeline**

**July 7** First Reading: Proposal to begin Redistricting Process

**July 14 / July 28:** Second Reading: City Council Work Session to discuss redistricting and to determine whether to move forward with the process

- Review population data and census tracts
- Review required redistricting process
- Discuss council member perspectives on structure of the City Council
- Decide whether to move forward by setting a timeline

**Aug 4:** Presentation of baseline map

- Council directs staff to prepare any desired alternative maps for consideration.

**Aug 11:** Presentation of alternative maps

- Council may request edits/amendments to the prepared alternative maps at this time.

**Aug 11 / Aug 18:** Council formally selects between 1-2 of the alternative maps to place before the public for their review and input

**Aug 19 – Sept 13:** Gather public input on the 1-3 maps chosen by the council

Public outreach process:

- A website that includes the maps and a place where the public can comment. Staff suggests keeping the question(s) surrounding the alternative maps specific (example: “Which alternative map do you prefer, A or B?”).
- A townhall, poster session, or district pop-ups where public feedback is gathered on the alternative maps.
- A survey sent out to residents to gather feedback on the alternative maps.

**Sept 22:** Final selection and adoption of a map

- a. Any public input is formally presented to the council.
- b. A public hearing is held.
- c. The council selects one of the alternative maps.
- d. The Council adopts an ordinance amending the municipal code defining the makeup of Sandy Council Districts and/or adopts a resolution amending the current districts map.
